Who Can Attend:

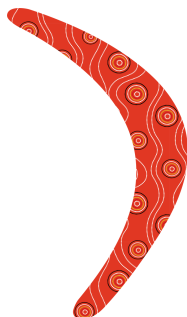
This event is open to all youth aged 7 - 12 years old.
